7. Are you practical, curious about the physical world, and interested in plants and animals?
8. Are you imaginative, innovative, and original?
9. Are you able to write and speak well to communicate ideas to others?

12. Are you able to remain calm in a crisis?
13. Do you like to be physically active?
14. Do you like to communicate ideas, work with audio, visual, graphic or written media arts?

17. Do you possess emotional stability and strong self-esteem?
