Career Link Academy & Programs

Academies and programs are courses of study that combine two years of secondary education with two years of postsecondary education. Students select a program of study they would like to pursue. Within that program of study, students take college courses while still in high school. Students receive high school and college credit for these classes, thus earning up to one year of college credit while still in high school. There is no cost to the student except for tools and transportation for industrial programs.
