About the Instructor: Bob McCoy and his wife, Bonnie, bought a Prairie School house in Rock Glen in 1993 and became interested in Prairie school architecture and architects. When he retired from an active 30-year practice of orthopedic surgery here in 1992, he and Peggy Bang, as co-chairs of the project, became active in the restoration of the Frank Lloyd Wright-Stockman house. That interest continued as he became Chair of the Stockman House Operating Committee, a member of the national board of the Frank Lloyd Wright Building Conservancy, the Walter Burley Griffin Society of America and other organizations having to do with historic preservation of architecture. He was local chair of the national meetings of the above named organizations when they held their national meetings in Mason City in 1993 and 2003. In 2002 he was made an honorary member of the American Institute of Architects. He is involved in committees working toward the construction of an Architectural Interpretive center in conjunction with the Stockman House and with Wright on the Park, Inc., in the process of rehabilitating "The Historic Park Inn Hotel" as a historic destination hotel.
