The Iowa Small Business (ISB) Loan Program was created by the legislature to help existing and new Iowa-based and Iowa-owned small businesses create and retain jobs.

Loans for \$2,500 to \$50,000 at 3.9% for direct loans or 2% for loans co-sponsored from August 1, 2010 to March 31, 2011 or until funds run out.
