UNI equivalents are designated by a departmental abbreviation followed by a course number. For example, in the course PSYCH 1001 the PSYCH refers to the Departments of Psychology and the 1001 refers to the course.

When an equivalent is listed as PSYCH 1000\_ (e.g. PSYCH 1000Z) the letter at the end indicates that the content of the transfer psychology course is not similar to the content of any UNI psychology course to be given a direct equivalent. When a course accepted for transfer does not seem to fit into any department at the University it will be given an equivalent of UNIV 1000Z. Even though these transfer courses may not be given exact UNI equivalents, they are still approved for transfer credit.

If a course satisfies a Liberal Arts Core (LAC) requirement, the category is indicated in the LAC column. If students are trying to satisfy requirements in an older UNI General Education program, they should consult the Office of Admissions at 800-772-2037 or 319-273-2281.
