# What is Career Link?

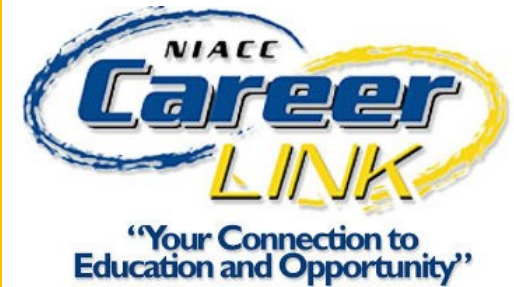
- Receive high school and college credit at the same time.
