- Enter the workforce with marketable skills

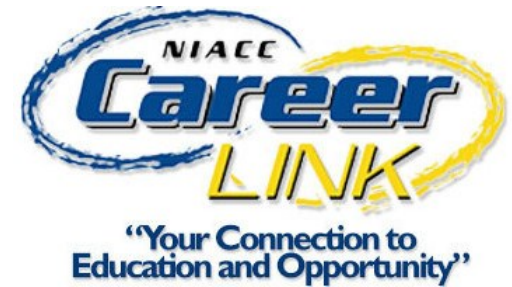
