



GRADUATION/TRANSFER/RETENTION RATES
 FIRST-TIME, FULL-TIME DEGREE/CERTIFICATE-SEEKING STUDENTS
 REPORTED APRIL 2020

In compliance with Student Right-to-Know legislation, NIACC would like to announce the graduation/completion rates for students who entered as full-time degree/certificate-seeking students for the first time in the fall of 2016. This cohort group consisted of **617** students. The anticipated graduation date for these students was spring 2018. One year after this date (August 2019 or 150% of the time typically required to graduate) **287** of these students had completed the program in which they originally enrolled. The resulting graduation rate was **47%**.

Also in compliance with the Student Right-to-Know legislation, NIACC has contracted with the National Student Clearinghouse to determine the number of students in this same cohort (full-time degree/certificate-seeking students who were full-time fall 2016) who transferred prior to graduation. There were **117** students located who had subsequently enrolled in another post-secondary institution by August of 2019. This results in a **19%** transfer-out rate. When the graduation rate and the transfer-out rate are added together, **66%** of the cohort group had achieved their goal of either graduating or transferring.

In compliance with the Student Right-to-Know Legislation, NIACC would like to announce our retention rate, as reported on IPEDS. This cohort group consisted of **575** full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking students enrolled for the fall 2018 semester. There were **361** students from the fall 2018 cohort who were still enrolled or who had completed their program as of fall 2019. The resulting retention rate was **63%**.
