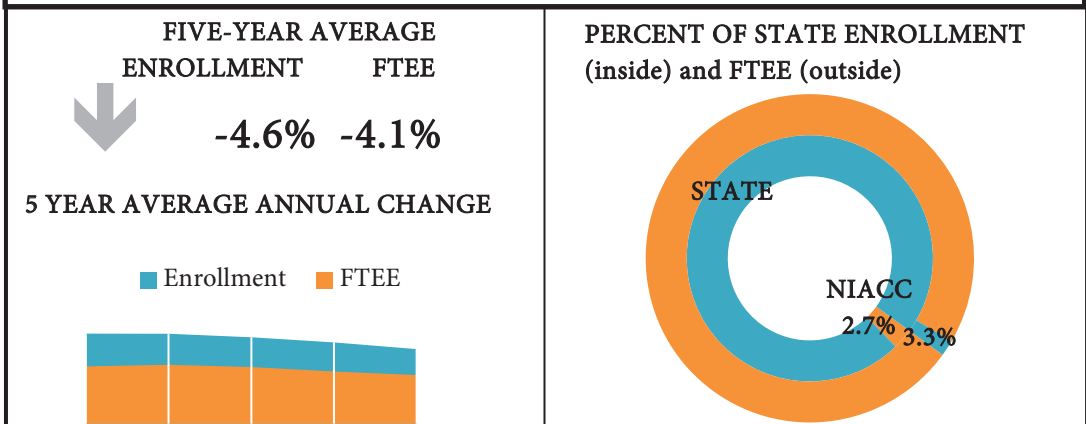

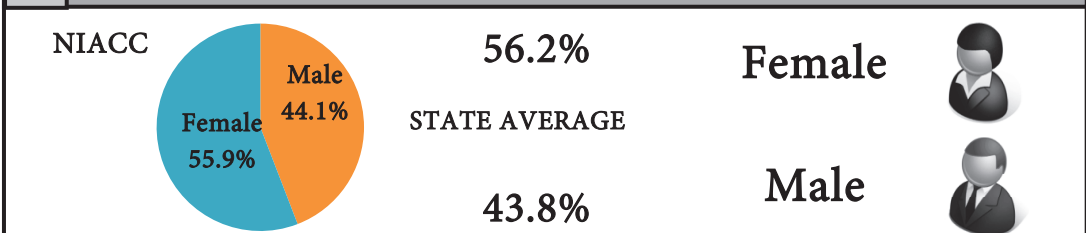

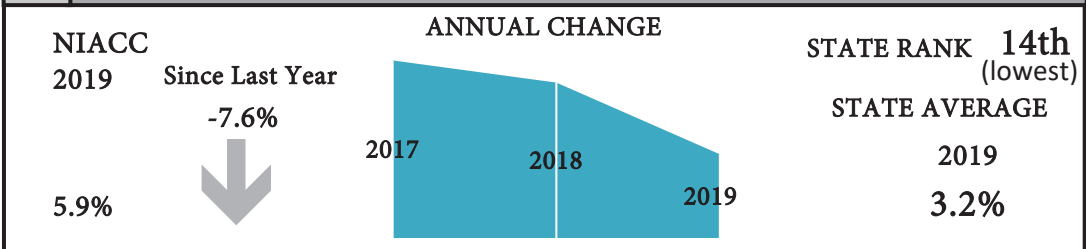

## 2 Enrollment by Gender



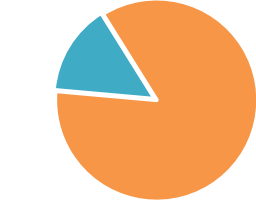

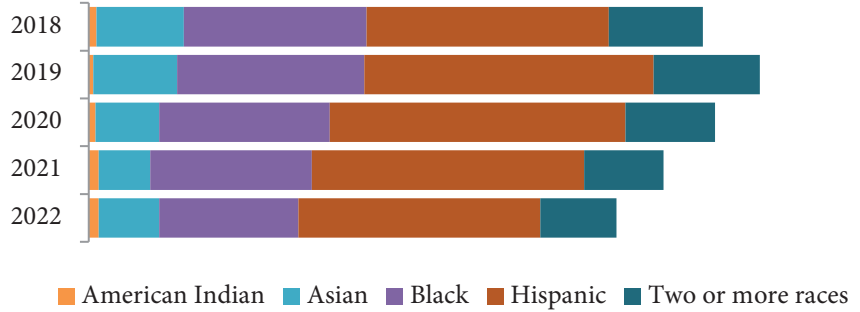

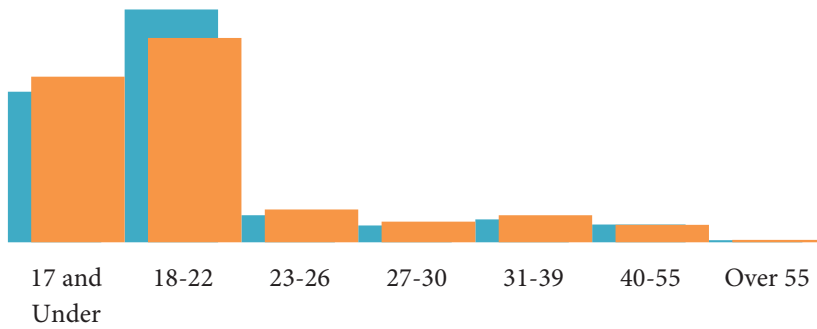

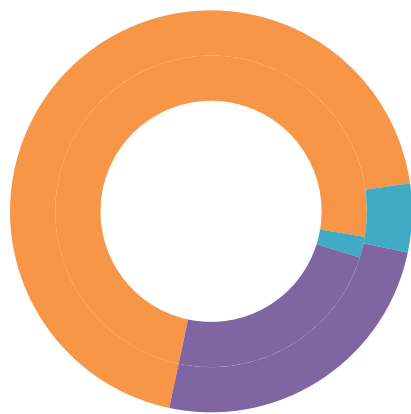

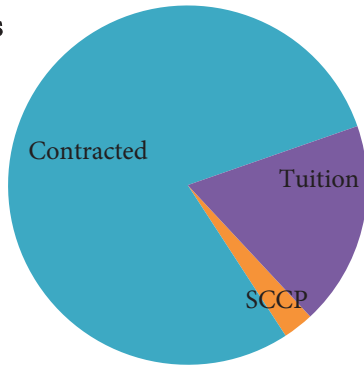

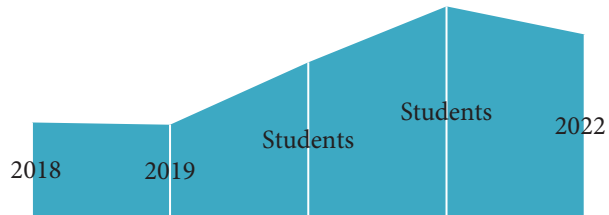

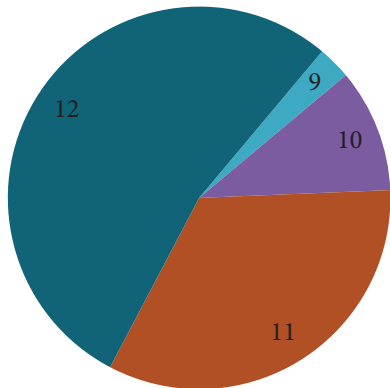

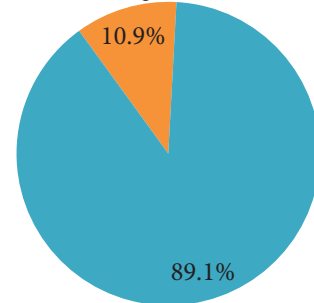

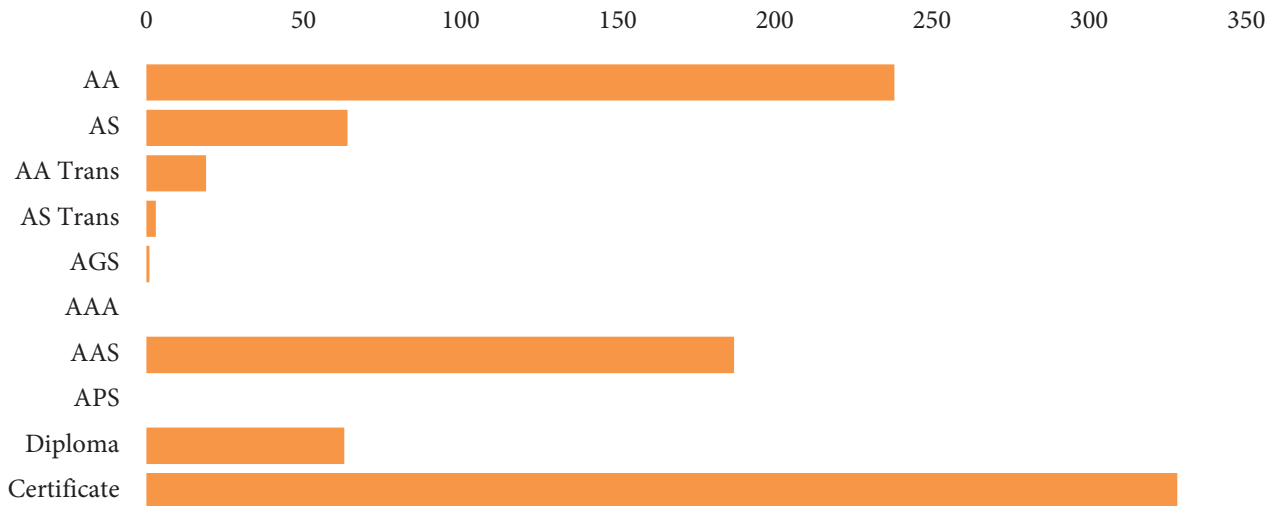
Five -Year Average Annual Change

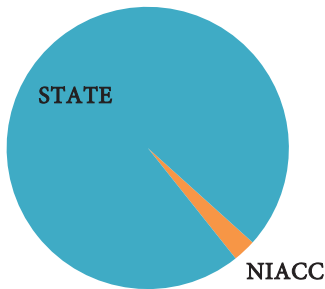

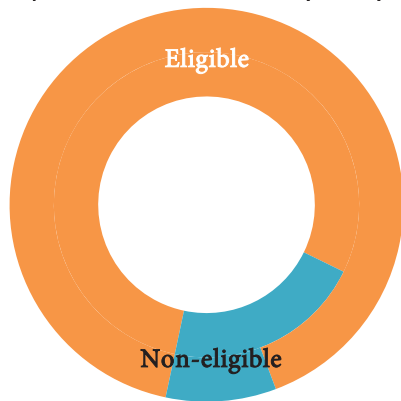

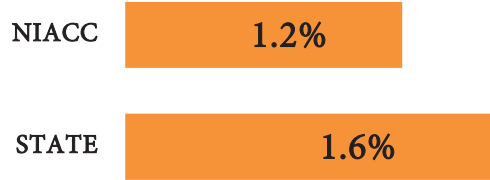
