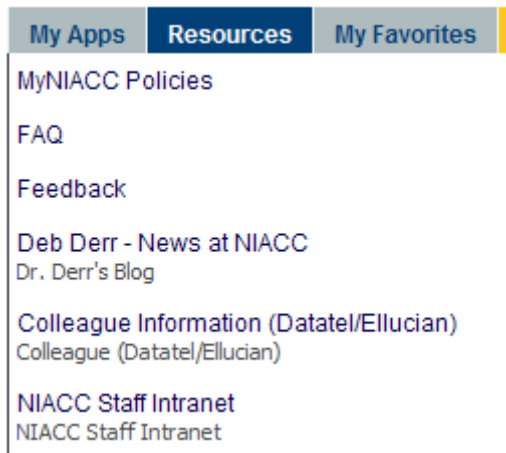

Once logged into MyNIACC, using your NIACC username & password, you will have quick access to the following:

- Self-Service WebAdvisor features
 - Don't see the self-service feature on Quick Links? Choose the "More" tab.
- Outlook Web Access
 - Great for off-campus or not-at-your-desk access to your e-mail
- Colleague UI 4.x
 - To use this feature, you must have a Datatel login and you'll need to allow pop-ups from niacc.edu
- My favorites
 - This allows you to manage your own personal links to websites

- My Week
 - Displays your Outlook calendar and class schedule
- Campus Events, Announcements, NIACC Alerts
- MyNIACC Charter (currently in draft)
 - Go to “Resources”, then “MyNIACC Policies”, to find the Portal Charter Draft. This documents covers direction and decisions related to MyNIACC.
